

Hot Summer Nights Car Show – Volunteer Do's & Don'ts

1. Be friendly to ALL car owners ...make them feel welcomed to our show and report any vandalism immediately!

2. Wear your yellow shirt – it identifies you as someone in authority willing to help in any situation **and discourages** others from doing foolish things.

3. Captains are responsible for putting up barricades, working to get vendors in and out and working w/Co-Captains and Co-Volunteers to ensure your location is secure and everyone is obeying the show rules – **do not leave** your post uncovered...radio for relieve.

4. Co-Captains have the same responsibilities as Captains **AND** will be responsible for taking over in the Captains absence – **do not leave** your post uncovered...radio for relief.

5. Floaters are responsible to be available for relief and help with traffic movement when bringing classic cars in.

6. Handle walkie talkies carefully – they are rented and worth \$1200 each.

7. Volunteers cannot drink alcohol on duty during the show.

8. All Volunteers will be provided a **free hot dog and beverage**. A ticket will be given to you when checking in at the Headquarter booth. Vendor is located next to the Veteran's Hall on Prospect & Hartz.

9. Water will be provided by Car Show – **stay hydrated**. **ALSO**, feel free to bring **chairs** if you have a street assignment!

10. No physical confrontations w/guests – **enlist police assistance** and provide description of problem person(s)

11. DO NOT ALLOW guests to sit in show cars without the owner's permission.

12. No biking or skate boarding allowed – **stop them** and ask them to walk.

13. Watch baby carriers and strollers. **Prevent** them from getting too close to the cars so that they won't scratch those expensive paint jobs.

14. No alcohol is allowed in public streets – **request** the guest to discard the container.

15. No loud stereos are allowed from show cars...**please address!**

16. Vendors must start breaking down their tents and putting them on the side walk at **3:30**. They cannot bring their trucks in prior to the cars leaving at **4:00**. **ALL Volunteers** are responsible for enforcing this time frame.

17. ALL CARS MUST remain until **4:00 p.m.**...**do not allow** them to leave before. If there is a confrontation, use walkie talkie to get assistance from the police!

18. End of event- Captains, Co-Captains and Volunteers will be notified to **remove barricades and assist** w/getting the cars out as quickly as possible at 4:00 p.m.
